

30 Simple Facts Every Believer Should Know

1. Our Father's name is not "the LORD". "the LORD" is Baal's title -- in fact, "Baal" is the Hebrew word for lord. Hosea 2:16,17
2. Our Father's name is Yah, which means "I AM". Scripture also shows it written YHWH, which is pronounced Yahowah, Yahweh, or Yahuah. Exodus 3:14, Psalm 68:4
3. Our Messiah's name was not "Jesus". There was no "J" sound in Hebrew, Aramaic, or Greek. The letter "J" was not invented until 1500 years after His resurrection; and the first record of the name "Jesus" was the 1629 revision of the King James Bible.
4. His name was Yahshua, just like "Joshua", who brought Israel into the promised land.
5. Yahshua means "Yah Saves"; or, since Yah means "I AM", "I AM Salvation". Matthew 1:21
6. He was not born on December 25th. Dec. 25th was the winter solstice when our Roman calendars were established, long celebrated by pagans as the birthday of the sun-god.
7. Pagans have decorated trees with silver and gold since hundreds of years before Messiah was born. These are called Asherah poles. Jeremiah 10:2-5
8. Copying these pagan customs is forbidden, even, and especially, if it is to worship Yah. He calls it an abomination. Deuteronomy 12:30-32
9. Yahshua kept the seventh-day Sabbath and Feasts described in Leviticus 23. John 7:37
10. The "Lord's Supper" was a Passover meal. Matthew 26:17-19.
11. Yahshua was sacrificed on Passover. Luke 23:54
12. Yahshua was in the grave on the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread. John 19:31
13. Yahshua was resurrected on the Feast of FirstFruits. John 20:1
14. The giving of the Spirit at Pentecost was the fulfillment of the Feast of Weeks. Acts 2:1
15. There are three more Feasts yet to be fulfilled - Trumpets, Atonement, and Tabernacles. Leviticus 23:23-44
16. Yahshua did not die on a cross. The early Greek texts consistently use the word "stauros", which means stake or pole. Mark 15:32
17. The cross has long been the symbol of Tammuz, the sun-god son of Baal and Asherah.
18. Easter is the German name of Asherah, the wife of Baal.
19. The date of "Easter" is calculated so that it NEVER falls at Passover.
20. "Lent" originated as "weeping for Tammuz", and is condemned by scripture. Ezekiel 8:14
21. Messiah did NOT come to abolish the law or "nail it to the cross". Matthew 5:17-19
22. Yahshua kept the seventh day Sabbath, and instructed His followers to do the same. Mark 2:28, Luke 23:56
23. There is no scriptural basis for abolishing Sabbath rest, or moving it to Sun-Day. Exodus 20:8-11
24. The move of sabbath rest to "the day of the venerable Sun" was ordered by the Roman emperor Constantine in the 4th century -- the very same Constantine who murdered his wife and son, and printed "Committed to the Invincible Sun" on his coins.
25. Daniel prophesied that "the beast" would "think to change times and laws". Daniel 7:25
26. Rome replaced Yah's feasts, found in Leviticus 23, with counterfeit holidays from pagan sun worship, and called them "Feasts of the LORD".
27. The apostles referred to Rome as Babylon. 1 Peter 5:13
28. In Revelation, Yah urges His people to come out of Babylon - to escape the influence of

the Roman church. Revelation 18:4

29. Babylon, and those who follow her traditions instead of Yah's commandments, will be destroyed. Revelation 14:8-11

30. Their fate is contrasted with that of the saints - defined as those who keep BOTH the commandments of Yah, and the faith of Yahshua. Revelation 14:12

"Not every one that saith unto me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?' And then will I profess unto them, 'I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.' Matthew 7:21-23

Then came to Yahshua scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying, "Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread." But he answered and said unto them, "Why do ye also transgress the commandment of Elohim by your tradition? For Elohim commanded, saying, 'Honour thy father and mother': and, 'He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.' But ye say, 'Whosoever shall say to his father or his mother, It is a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; And honour not his father or his mother, he shall be free.' Thus have ye made the commandment of Elohim of none effect by your tradition. Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, '**This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me. But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.**' Matthew 15:1-9

"Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. Elohim is a Spirit: and **they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.**" John 4:22-24

And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, "Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters: With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication." So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, **having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication: And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.** And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Yahshua: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. Revelation 17:1-6
